# 9.1 District Council of Renmark Paringa – Renmark SMP (255/24)

# **Resolution 88.9.1.1:** The Authority resolved to:

- (1) **Approve** a contribution to the District Council of Renmark Paringa for up to \$60,000 for the development of the Renmark Stormwater Management Plan (including Calperum Industrial Estate) to be matched dollar for dollar by the District Council of Renmark Paringa, subject to:
  - a. the finalisation of the scope to the satisfaction of the Technical Advisor and the General Manager; and
  - b. the confirmation of approval of the study area from the Murraylands and Riverland Landscape Board.

# 9.2 City of Holdfast Bay- Harrow Road GPT variation 215/21

# **Resolution 88.9.2.1:** The Authority resolved to:

- (1) **Approve** a variation to grant 215/21 to increase the approved funding amount from \$200,000 to up to \$225,082 where the Authority will meet 1/3 of the cost of the design and construction of the Harrow Road GPT with the remaining 2/3 to be met by the Cities of Holdfast Bay and Marion.
- (2) **Approve** the extension of the end date of the project from 30 June 2024 to 31 May 2025.
